- <u>Use</u>: Flamma is coming in hot! Not only does Flamma have exceptional heat tolerance in the field, but this celosia stuns with early, uniform flowering. Creates prodigious display of long-lasting, feathery, deep-red blooms. Late-flowering variety is low upkeep, high impact. Great cut flowers. Flamma Orange is a 2022 AAS Winner!
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- <u>Growth</u>: Bewitching 16-18" tall and 10-12" wide plants create drama blazing away in the autumn landscape, mingling in the midborder, or unleashing a blast of color from a lucky patio container.
- *Hardiness: Zone* 9-11, Annual, Houseplant. WILL NOT TOLERATE BELOW 50 DEGREES.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Green foliage in long spade shaped leaf.
- **<u>Flower:</u>** Available in five vivid colors and one mix, Flamma provides vibrant plumes of color that won't fade rising above the foliage from early summer to mid fall. The flowers are excellent for cutting.
