- <u>Use:</u> Great for use in containers, flowerbeds, and large landscapes. Loved by hummingbirds. Petunia Limbo has large, Grandiflora-sized flowers that cover a dwarf plant habit, and when other petunias stretch, the Limbos will not. All of the colors in the series put on impressive, easy-care shows in pots, beds and mass plantings throughout the Summer, right up until fall frost.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- <u>Growth</u>: The ultimate plant size is only 6 to 7 inches tall, spreading 10 to 12 inches.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 8b-11 Annual, Many people have success with them reseeding and coming back every year. Can handle light frosts above 26 degrees.
- *Foliage*: Deciduous. Pinch back tips occasionally for a super bushy plant.
- **Flower:** Trumpet-shaped flowers that are 4+ inches across. The Limbo™ Series deliver large blooms and an even plant growing habit among all the colors in the series. They come in a wide variety of bright colors and do well from early spring until late fall.
