Drought tolerant!



- <u>Use:</u> Purslane perform well in heat and drought and naturally load up
 with small, colorful blooms. Use purslane in hanging baskets or as colorful cascading elements in combination planters. This is the plant for you if
 can't remember to water or have a terribly hot baking situation. This relative of the cactus is the solution for you then!
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full hot sun! Water when top 3 in. of soil is dry, allowing
 to dry out slightly in between waterings. Use slow release fertilizer for best
 results. If you forget to water they will forgive you, but don't over water
 them!
- **Growth:** Grows 12-15" tall and 15-18" wide, maybe taller if deep shade or rich soil. Use in patio containers, hanging baskets and beds
- *Hardiness: Zone* 9-11, annual, houseplant. Protect from temperatures below 40 degrees.
- Foliage: Small leaves.
- Flower: Bright yellow-, orange-, or rose-, or white-colored blooms. Purslane will add tons of color with a minimum of care from you. Blossoms persist from spring to fall. The cheerful, chalice-like blooms close up at night, but pop back open as soon as the sun peeks over the horizon.
