- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– shade (less color on leaves in shade), very easy to please. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Superb in borders, beds, and open woodland gardens.
- **Growth**: Grows quickly24-40" tall or more and about 18-30" wide
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 9-10, Annual or Houseplant, some people have luck with them coming back in sheltered locations with good drainage, but that depends on the winter.
- <u>Foliage</u>: As shiny as a new penny! Copper foliage dominates this new award winning annual and you are going to love how it makes all your other foliage and flowers pop with an explosion of color. Twin leaves that emerge from the previous on square stems have a burgundy tint and then develop a copper sheen that is unrivaled in the annual world of foliage
- <u>Flower:</u> If flowers start to form or if your plant is getting taller than desired, we recommend pinching it back to your desired height. The plant will in turn produce more foliage for a fuller looking plant.
