
Inca II Marigold



An outstanding choice for color and fill in sunny landscape applications. Loves the heat and blooms until late October frosts!

Tagetes erecta 'Inca II'

- <u>Use</u>: Inca II is a brilliantly colored, early blooming, fully double marigold with strong stems on compact plants. If you are looking for a reliable garden performer, this is the marigold for you! And the plants aren't quite as tall as the old Inca, giving them better weather resistance and staying power in the garden, with slightly smaller blooms.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun.
 Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- <u>Growth</u>: The compact plant size—just 12 to 13 inches tall and 10 inches across.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 8-11, Treated as an annual, houseplant in our area
- **Flower:** These blooms reach 3 to $3\frac{1}{2}$ inches across, with a fully double form that keeps its petal-packed beauty all season long. The flowers are long lasting, ultra-colorful, and freely borne.
