Ice Baby Daffodils





Narcissus 'Ice Baby'

- <u>Use:</u> Daffodils are great for naturalizing, so you'll enjoy these beauties year after year. Heat tolerant, long-lasting flowers are excellent for cutting. Beds, rock gardens, in patio planters, and woodland garden. We find it to truly be the easiest bulb to plant in the garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows 10-12" tall.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 3-8; Perennial. Bulb.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. Do not cut off the leaves after flowering.
- <u>Flower:</u> Beautiful yet petite, 2" daffs emerge a soft yellowgreen and mature to greenish-white. They boast an exotic star shape that is quite uncommon for daffodils. Trumpet type.

- Planting density: 6 inch apart, 4-5 per sq. ft.
- Planting depth: 8 inches
 to base of the bulb.
- Best planted in a mass of 30 or more for dramatic effect.
