

## Brassica oleracea 'Bravo'

- <u>Use</u>: 85 Days. Outstanding field performance. This rugged hybrid has performed well from the Deep South in winter to the North in summer. The large, round heads are uniform and a beautiful bluegreen color. Use close spacing (10-12 in.) for market and wide spacing (18-24") for sauerkraut.
- Exposure/Soil: Full to part sun. They must have well-drained soils, so if you have red clay you must amend it. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- <u>Growth</u>: Grows 12" tall and wide. Recommended spacing is 12 to 15 inches on rows at least three feet apart. You can also increase production in small garden by planting a double row on a bed.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 3-9; Vegetable; Can be planted in spring or fall. Not heat hardy.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Produces large, blue-green heads with cream colored inside.
- Flower: Not known for flowers.
