- <u>Use:</u> 1977 All-America Selections Winner! 78 days. (F1) This variety produces good yields of fine quality savoy type cabbage. The interior is excellent. Sold in supermarkets as cut halves in shrink wrap. This variety adapts to all regions.
- Exposure/Soil: Full to part sun. They must have well-drained soils, so if you have red clay you must amend it. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth**: Grows 12" tall and wide. Recommended spacing is 12 to 15 inches on rows at least three feet apart. You can also increase production in small garden by planting a double row on a bed.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Vegetable; Can be planted in spring or fall.
- *Foliage:* The crops produces large 3 ½ lb deep green heads. Very firm with a tender, sweet flavor. Holds well and is widely used for a more reliable harvest..
- Flower: Not known for flowers.
