Red Knight Pepper



Because of its large size, Red Knight makes an excellent stuffing and grilling pepper. Red Knight will save your early Summer salads, snacks and side dishes all season long!

- <u>Use</u>: Improved King Arthur type. Big, blocky fruits are early to turn red. Stronger disease resistance than King Arthur and a more compact, open plant. Flavor is fruity and sweet. Widely adapted.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Plants can grow 3 to 4 ft tall.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 9-11, Annual, Houseplant.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Small leaves. Disease Resistance: Bacterial Leaf Spot races 1–3, 7, 8 (High) Potato Virus Y races 0 (High)
- *Flower:* An early-maturing and blocky bell pepper. It produces an extra large fruit that goes from green to bright red at maturity.
