- <u>Use</u>: Have a taste of 'Italian Honey' and you will be utterly seduced. Growing to just 8 feet, this attractive and prolific cultivar is an enticing presence in a patio container. - <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Grow in full sun. Well-drained, rich soil. pH of 5.5 to 6.5 necessary.
- **Growth**: They can grow up to 4-8 feet tall and wide, but up to 20' possibly with age.
- Hardiness: Zone 7b-10; Tree.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. Do not prune mature trees heavily because this can reduce the crop.
- Flower/ Fruit: Amber colored flesh and yellow skin.
