Goji Berry Bush



These bright orange-red berries help our immune system ward off disease. They are juicy and sweet when eaten fresh, and when dried, are similar to cranberries or dates. Can be enjoyed as a healthy snack, or made into juice, wine and tea. Glossy foliage and a graceful arching habit. Produces white to purple blooms in early summer.

Lycium barbarum

- <u>Use:</u> Goji berries are often referred to as the Super-fruit and are known for their high levels of vitamins and minerals. Goji berries can easily be grown in your garden or as a shrub in the landscape. They will thrive in alkaline soils and require little care.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full to part sun.
- Growth: : Grows 8-10' tall and wide.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 5-9; Shrub
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous; Foliage is very feathery, open and airy. Plants are fast growing with slender silver-blue leaves.
- Glossy foliage and a graceful arching habit. Produces white to purple blooms in early summer.

 Fruit Plants will produce flowers and fruit the second year after planting. Fruits are tomato red in color and hang from the branches and when dried, resemble a raisin
