
## Husky Red Tomato



Requiring no pruning, the dwarf, indeterminate vines will grow to about 4ft.
Plants are resistant to Verticillium Wilt, Fusarium Wilt (Races 1 and 2), Alternaria Stem Canker, and Gray Leaf Spot (Stemphylium).



- Lycopersicum 'Husky Red'
- <u>Use</u>: You'll be amazed at the large, 5-7 ounce fruits harvested from this beautiful dwarf tomato plant! Husky Red is a highly productive indeterminate variety that grows like a determinate. Resistant to a variety of diseases, including verticillium wilt, fusarium wilt (races 1 and 2), alternaria stem canker and gray leaf spot, this is an ideal choice for containers, raised beds or small garden spaces. 68 days to maturity.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: FULL SUN! Soak to depth of 6 to 10 inches when watering. They need at least 6 hours of direct sunlight a day. Tomatoes hate red clay so use a good soil such as our PRO\_MIX.
- <u>Growth</u>: Grows 4– 8' tall and wide. Needs a very strong wooden stake or a tomato cage is best.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 9-11, Annual, houseplant.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Dark green quilted leaves.
- <u>Fruit</u>: Look for a no-nonsense yield of 7oz, medium-size red Tomatoes for sandwiches, salads, and fresh eating about 67-70 days from transplant.
