- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- Growth: Grows 3-5' tall and 2-3' wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 9-11, Annual, Houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Lacy leaves
- **Fruit:** An early bearing vigorous tomato that produces a huge yield of bright red 3/4-1 inch diameter tomatoes. Tidy Treats is perfect for container or small space gardening. It produces bite-sized cherry tomatoes in grape-like clusters all summer providing a constant supply of flavorful, meaty, sweet treats that are perfect as a snack right from the plant or for adding to salads or vegetable trays.
