

- *Use:* Stubby, needle-shaped aromatic leaves tightly cling to reddish brown stems that lay flat on the ground, bearing bee -friendly mauve-pink blooms in spring. Awash with soft pastel shades, Juniper Thyme can be threaded between pavers and draped over rock work or container edges.
- stepping Exposure/Soil: Tolerates full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
 - **Growth:** Moderate grower 2-4" tall x 8-10" wide and continues to spread by underground shoots.
 - Hardiness: Zone 4-9, Perennial
 - Foliage: Evergreen. Dense carpet of needle like grey green leaves.
 - **Flower:** Blooms in early to mid-spring with loads of bright pink flowers.
