## Aglaonema 'Very Red'

- <u>Use:</u> With its red and green leaves this stunning houseplant has an easy care routine! It's a slow-growing plant, so you can enjoy it without worrying if it will grow out of bounds. Older, larger plants are suited to growing on the floor --- in corners, next to furniture, or as an accent piece along a wall. The red tones in Chinese evergreen's leaves let you have some fun choosing pots. Not recommended for human or animal consumption.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: It tolerates lower light well, but also grows well in bright spots where you will have better leaf color. It doesn't even need natural light to thrive --- Chinese evergreen does just fine in offices with fluorescent lighting. equally low-care when it comes to water; you can water regularly, keeping the soil evenly moist, or water once every few weeks and Chinese evergreen will do equally well. It doesn't require fertilizer, but will grow best if fertilized once or twice a year in spring or summer (or every six months) with a general-purpose houseplant fertilizer.
- **Growth**: Grows slowly 36" tall and wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 10b-11b; Houseplant
- **Foliage:** Thanks to its exotic red-and-green leaf variegation, it is a show-stopper in any houseplant collection.
- <u>Flower:</u> It has cute, calla-lily-like blooms in spots where it gets enough light.
