- <u>Use:</u> This tree fern is 3 to 4 feet tall. The fronds are bright green. It can be grown outdoors year round in zones 10 and 11, but otherwise it can be used as a houseplant. In zones 9 and lower, move the plant outdoors for the summer and then bring it indoors as a houseplant for the winter or treat it as a houseplant all year.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Medium, indirect dappled light will bring out the best in them
 (picture them under a thick canopy of trees on a sunny day). Avoid direct sunlight, especially in the summer when the sun's rays are intense! need constant moisture, but don't let them sit in standing water; you will regret it! Love
 high humidity.
- **Growth:** The gracefully arching fronds grow 3-4 ft. high and 2-3'wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 10a-11b; Houseplant They prefer to live in cooler temps but can withstand temperatures into the 90's. They'll just need more water and shade during a heatwave.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen indoors; If fabulous fronds are a must, then look no further! Symmetrical leaflets feature a slight ripple and emerge from a central stem to give the Silver Lady Fern a distinctive architectural look. The fronds grow in a rosette formation, and with time and proper care, these plants can grow to be rather tall.
- <u>Flower</u>: none, reproduces by spores

Increased humidity keeps the green fronds of the Silver Lady looking lush, and make sure to water when the top inch of the soil is dry to the touch. Non-toxic to pets!
