Neon Pothos





This plant filters pollutants from the air while releasing oxygen. With this plant in your home, you breathe cleaner air.

- They are attractive, durable and easy to grow vines that have smooth, leathery, heart shaped leaves with distinctive marbling alternating along rope-like green stems.
- Pothos vines are among the top ten air purifying plants for indoor use.
- Not recommended for human or animal consumption.

Epipremnum aureum 'Neon' /Scindapsus aureus

- <u>Use</u>: As one of the most popular and eye-catching varieties of pothos, neon pothos are low-fuss houseplants that are sure to brighten up any corner of your home. Please keep away from pets and children.
- Exposure/Soil: Can tolerate low light conditions, but will cause the variegation to fade. They do best in filtered light, although a little morning sun is permissible. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry, but take care not to overwater. Use slow release fertilizer for best results.
- <u>Growth</u>: Will continue to grow in the basket. make excellent hanging plants, but they will never reach their full potential unless they are allowed to climb upright on a totem pole. Totems give the plant's air roots something to attach to for support.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 10-12, Annual, Houseplant, Bring indoors below 60 degrees.
- Foliage: Neon yellow heart shaped leaves.
- Flower: No flowers.
