Selaginella kraussiana 'Aurea'

- <u>Use:</u> A low creeping mat with attractive moss-like semievergreen foliage of a yellow green color. This pre-historic fern relative creates a stunning contrast around dark greens. One of the most vigorous-growing "Tropical Club Mosses", this golden form adds a touch of brilliance to potted containers or terrarium design. Grow as a miniature in a small pot or hanging basket and will spill down the sides.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Easy to grow in part shade to shade. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. DO NOT FORGET TO WATER!
- **Growth:** Forms a 6-inch high and 2' wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: 8-11, Annual, houseplant; May be hardy with winter protection from wind and frost.
- *Foliage*: The creeping stems create a dense mat, quickly covering the soil's surface.
- Flower: No flowers, but spores.
