## Acorus gramineus 'Ogon'

- <u>Use:</u> A spreading tuft of tiny golden evergreen grass-like foliage. Makes a bright groundcover in moist areas or as a driveway edger... a real highlight in the woodland garden. Butter-yellow sword-like blades add wonderful contrast all season. Deer resistant.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers Part Sun to Light Shade.
  Prefers moist soils. Divide only in spring.
- **Growth:** Grows to 6-14" in. high and space 12" apart.
- *Hardiness*: 5-10 perennial.
- Foliage: Evergreen. Rich golden variegated blades weep gently. Crushed foliage emits sweet scent.
- Flower: Not known for flowers.
