- <u>Use:</u> Selected for its profusion of long lasting, deep violet blue flower spikes, that appear from July to September and fragrant foliage. Prefers average to dry locations, and is a butterfly magnet. A long flowering, heat and drought tolerant, as well as insect and disease resistant.
 - Exposure/Soil: They should be grown in well-drained soil in full sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers.
- <u>Growth</u>: Full, well branched plants grow 3' tall and 3' wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: 5-10 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Flower:** Blue spikes of flowers from June until late fall.

flies!
