
Curtain call Deep Rose Anemone









Anemone 'Curtain Call Deep Rose

- <u>Use:</u> A shorter stature Japanese Anemone that's perfect for extending the season in the garden. Beginning in late summer, this perennial produces dark rose pink flowers that are positioned right above a small mound of green foliage.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: In cooler climates, they can be grown in full sun if a consistant supply of moisture is available. In warmer zones, they need protection from the hot, midday sun; dappled shade is ideal. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Plant them in rich, loose, well-drained soil. Dry or excessively wet soil and windy conditions are a sure downfall of this plant. Always best to water under leaves.
- <u>Growth</u>: Moderate growing; reaches 14 to 18 in. tall, 16 to 18 in. wide.
 Spreads slowly through rhizomes.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 4-8; Perennial. Very easy to grow!
- *Foliage*: Deciduous; Green foliage is a great backdrop for the flowers.
- <u>Flower:</u> Semi-double, deep rosy pink blossoms won't interest bunnies or Bambi, but they will attract pollinators and human admirers. From summer until fall. The seed heads look like little fluffy cotton balls, standing atop strong stems to give interest to the garden from fall into winter.
