

Little Lanterns Eastern Red Columbine



Aquilegia canadensis 'Little Lanterns'

- **Use:** This beautiful woodland wildflower has showy, drooping, bell-like flowers equipped with distinctly backward-pointing tubes, similar to the garden Columbines. An upright plant just right for the shady perennial border, patio, woodland plantings, or accents. Columbines are one of the easiest and most rewarding of all perennials. Their flowers are a treasure in spring and when they are through flowering their waxy green foliage continues to add grace to the garden. An eastern American native wildflower.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun– shade. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly 10" tall and 8-10" wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Ternate, almost fern-like, basal green foliage with a bluish tinge.
- **Flower:** Features drooping, bell-like, 1-2", red and yellow flowers (red sepals, yellow-limbed petals, 5 distinctive red spurs and a mass of bushy yellow stamens).



- **Attracts Hummingbirds and Butterflies.**
- **Deer Resistant and Rabbit Resistant.**
- **Good for Cut Flowers**
- **Long Blooming 4 weeks or more**
