
Birch's Bellflower







- <u>Use:</u> Profuse blooming with nodding cup shaped flowers of purple blue. Excellent for walls and crevices this poscharskyana and garganica cross (hybrid) will bloom all summer long.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full—part sun Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter.
- **Growth:** Short, mounding ground cover with a sprawling habit approximately 4-10" tall. Space 20" apart.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 3-8; Perennial.
- Foliage: Deciduous. The dark green thread leaf foliage makes a great contrast with the flower color.
- **Flower:** Showy cup-shaped, purple-blue flowers appear over a long season from mid-spring into summer.
