Diamond Head Elephant Ears





Colocasia esculenta 'Diamond Head'

- <u>Use</u>: A stunning new addition to the world of elephant ears. Diamond Head's broad, blue-black leaves have a smooth surface and a lustrous sheen that reflects the light.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– part shade. For best color, grow it in full sun. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. The more water and fertilizer they get the better. Could grow in a well aerated pond.
- in one sea- *Growth:* It makes a giant clump to 4' tall and 5' wide.
 - *Hardiness: Zone* 7b-10, perennial, mulch 1' around plant in fall
 - *Foliage:* Deciduous. Large dark purple to black leaves with a spectacular glossy finish
 - *Flower:* Not known for flowers.
