- **Use:** Most used as a height accent in containers and in small garden plantings. Looks elegant as a houseplant. May plant in the ground in spring and they will come back in a protected area with a good mulch layer before winter.
- **Exposure/Soil:** This unique and very hardy plant can be grown at any light level. It's fairly drought tolerant and needs little water. In the summers you can put them outside on the patio.
- **Growth:** Grows to 3-4' tall and wide in one season, but in a smaller container they will not likely grow that large.

Super tough and ' drought tolerant! Foliage: Semi-evergreen. Long spiky leaves.

- *Hardiness:* 7b-10 tender perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
