## ***Dianthus 'Diana Series'***

- **Use:** Non-stop flowers from October until April! Very long blooming throughout the year almost! Compact plant habit with large single flowers in a wide range of colors. Planted out in the garden, it continues to form masses of large blooms on a low growing plant. A good addition to the front border or used as an edging along a walk way. Will bloom for many years!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to part sun. Moderate water requirements, but somewhat drought tolerant. Must amend the soil if you have poor soil (like red clay). We recommend the Pro Mix Soil.
- **Growth:** Full sized plants grow to 10 inches tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zones 6-9; A cool-season annual (actually a biennial or short-lived perennial(2-3 years at least though). It will bloom in spring and fall, often going dormant during summer in warm climates. In our warm summers, it will rest, but may go into winter despite light frosts. Either way, it is long-blooming and beautiful in any setting!
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Small dark green narrow leaves.
- **Flower:** Extra-large, 2 to 2-1/2 in. blooms dominate the 8-10 in. basal-branching plants, in a blaze of showy color. Long bloom time.
