Raspberry Surprise Dianthus









- <u>Use:</u> The mounding, blue green, evergreen foliage on Raspberry Surprise makes a great groundcover in borders, edging and mixed containers. It is extremely floriferous and easy to grow, with dazzling double pink, scented blooms with a burgundy center in spring.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- <u>Growth:</u> The habit is compact and mounding to a height of about 12" tall and wide.
- Hardiness: 4-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** The evergreen, glaucous grey-green foliage provides a stark contrast for these shockingly showy flowers.
- <u>Flower:</u> Very fragrant, double, pink blossoms with a red center. Even more wonderful, the flowers exude the spicy scent of cloves. Though budding is most prolific in early summer, plants often rebloom in the fall. Prune off old flowers for longest bloom time.
