White Coneflower









Echinacea purpurea 'Pow Wow White'

- <u>Use:</u> As a specimen, in borders, or massed. Good choice for meadow or prairie gardens. Deer resistant, drought tolerant. Attracts butterflies
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full— part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- <u>Growth</u>: Moderate-growing to 12-16 in. tall and wide.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 3-9; Perennial
- *Foliage:* Long oval leaves. Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Pure white flowers with a golden yellow cone measured 3-4" across with wide, overlapping, reflexed petals. From early summer until fall frost, the flowers are produced prolifically on stiff, well-branched stems. More branches result in more flowers per plant and a showier display in the landscape.
