Makes a bright little groundcover in moist areas or as a feature between stepping stones... a real highlight in the woodland garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers Part Sun to Light Shade.
- Growth: Grows to 3 in. high and 14" wide.
- Hardiness: 5-10 perennial.
- *Foliage:* Evergreen.
- Flower: Not known for flowers.
