Blue Bayou Pampas Grass





Drought tolerant and needs little water once established.

An architectural plant that • moves gracefully in breezes.

Cortaderia selloana 'Blue Bayou'

- <u>Use:</u> A shorter blue-foliaged Pampas Grass that produces many large ivory plumes in late summer that persist into winter. Has an upright fountain shape that reaches 5 to 6 feet tall and 5 feet wide. Perfect for large urns and decorative planters.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower 5'-6' tall x 5' wide (and up to 7' tall and 10' wide over time)
- *Hardiness: Zone* 6b-10b, Perennial/ Grass
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. Glacous, long leaves are sharp. Cut back in the winter to 2' tall for best look.
- **Flower:** It is extremely showy with its numerous (100+ on mature specimens) large, fluffy white flower heads that are held on stout stems.
