## Lirope muscari 'Love Potion #13'

- <u>Use:</u> A superior selection whose foliage remains dark green throughout winter, has high resistance to crown rot, and good cold and drought tolerance. Flowers are more intense, uniform and long lasting. Use along the front of borders or as a groundcover Also known as Monkeygrass. Most popular for using as an edger from the lawn to your garden. Emerald Goddess can easily be confused with other liriopes based only on it's appearance but the real differences come in its resistance. It has a good resistance to common fungal and bacterial plant pathogens that often plague some liriopes. Stays more upright during the winter months.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 3 hours afternoon sun for good leaf coloring.
- <u>Growth:</u> Grows 16" tall and spreads to 2-3 feet tall over 3 years. Excellent for edging and ground covers. When plantings space 12-15" apart at least for fast display. Mow down with lawnmower to 3" tall in February for a clean look.
- Hardiness: Zone 5-9, Perennial
- <u>Foliage</u>: Evergreen. It has dark green foliage.
  - <u>Flower:</u> Produces purple-blue blooms that are stable from mid June through early September. It's floral display has better intensity, height uniformity and duration than other liriope varieties.
