## Lirope muscari 'Variegata'

- <u>Use:</u> Also known as Lirope variegated lily-turf, is as it's name implies, a variegated border
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun— part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 3 hours afternoon sun for good leaf coloring.
- **Growth:** Grows 9 to 12" tall and spreads to 2-3 feet tall over 3 years. Excellent for edging and ground covers. When plantings space 12-15" apart at least for fast display. Mow down with lawnmower to 3" tall in February for a clean look.
- *Hardiness:* 5-9, Perennial
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. The grassy foliage is edged with creamy yellow.
- <u>Flower:</u> It has purple-blue blooms, similar to grape hyacinths in summer.

## Low maintenance.
