Compact Maiden Grass



Miscanthus sinensis 'Adaigo'

<u>Use:</u> Attractive ornamental grass with fine-textured silvergreen blades that turn golden-bronze after first frost. The flower heads are puffy plumes that form in late summer to fall and make good cut or dried flowers. Very similar to Maiden Grass but more compact in growth.

Great specimen or used in groups as a screen.

- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 4 hours afternoon sun.
- Growth: Compact grower reaching 2-3 feet in height.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: 4-9, Perennial
- Foliage: Evergreen. They are clump forming plants with reed-like stems and leaves that are narrow and arch to the ground.
- **Flower:** Delicate silvery-white plumes in the fall.
