Low maintenance and non-invasive.

Ophiopogon planiscapus 'Black Beard' ('Yapard') PP22128

- <u>Use:</u> Infamous for its leathery, almost black evergreen foliage, well suited as a small scale ground cover. Fantastic against chartreuse plants. An attractive, tufted evergreen perennial groundcover with arching, grass-like foliage. Superior edging or border for partially shaded areas. Tighter growth and faster growing than other cultivars on the market.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun— part sun. Needs at least 3 hours afternoon sun for good leaf coloring. Prefers moist, but not wet soils. Tolerates drier conditions when established.
- <u>Growth:</u> Slow spreading. Grows 12" tall. Mow down with lawnmower to 3" tall in February for a clean look.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 7a-10b, Perennial
- *Foliage:* Evergreen. The dark green grassy foliage.
- <u>Flower:</u> Pink tinged, white flowers followed by black berries.
