Low maintenance and non-invasive.

Ophiopogon planiscapus 'Nigrescens'

- <u>Use:</u> Infamous for its leathery, almost black evergreen foliage, well suited as a small scale ground cover. Fantastic against chartreuse plants. An attractive, tufted evergreen perennial groundcover with arching, grass-like foliage. Superior edging or border for partially shaded areas.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun– part sun. Needs at least 3 hours afternoon sun for good leaf coloring. Prefers moist, but not wet soils. Tolerates drier conditions when established.
- <u>Growth</u>: Slow spreading. Grows 4-8" tall. Mow down with lawnmower to 3" tall in February for a clean look.
- *Hardiness:* 5-9, Perennial
- *Foliage:* Evergreen. The dark green grassy foliage.
- *Flower:* Pink tinged, white flowers followed by black berries.
