- <u>Use:</u> Delightful dwarf daylilies reward you by blooming twice a year! Their compact size makes them ideal in borders and rock gardens. The fact that these profuse bloomers multiply annually makes them even more appealing. Perfect for edging a border, pathway or growing in a container. Early to mid-season rebloomer, known as "the best in the business", this variety has 3" rose-red recurved blooms with a slightly bluish cast. These daylilies have been dubbed "Dwarf Reblooming Daylilies" because of their abundant small flowers, low height, and reblooming nature.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun (but must be 5-6 hours of afternoon sun). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Do not give too much nitrogen or they will not produce flowers. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** These outstanding varieties produce mounds of 12-20" tall foliage and bloom on stems up to 24" high.
- Hardiness: Zones 3-9; Perennial
- Foliage: Semi-evergreen.
- **Flower:** Raspberry-red, 3" flowers on 12-15" stems. Early to midsummer blooms are often followed by repeat blooms that last until fall.

Plant these once and enjoy years and years of flowers.
