- Exposure/Soil: Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- Growth: Clumping foliage 12 in. tall, 22 in. wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 4-8; Perennial
- <u>Foliage</u>: Semi-evergreen. The rich tone-on-tone purples permeate the fluted-edged, silver-veiled foliage. Throughout the day, the sunlight alters foliage colors creating varying shades of purple. Recipient of numerous awards!
- **Flower:** Very short spikes of purple-pink flowers in summer and four seasons of purple.
