Because of their low, mounding habit, they are often used as edging along paths or in containers. Try cutting a few of the tall flower scapes for fresh bouquets.

- <u>Use:</u> Now here's a beautiful accent for the partly to fully shaded border or container: a brilliantly variegated perennial with large, maple-leaf-like foliage of golden with generous maroon markings.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun (afternoon shade preferred)-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to 10" tall, 16" in bloom overall, by 15" wide.
- *Hardiness:* **Zone** 5-8; Perennial
 - **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Emerges with bright yellow leaves with thin red markings. It adds a vivid splash of tropical color to the border or containers. Slightly trailing mounds are the perfect for lining beds or interplanting with taller perennials.
- <u>Flower:</u> Small white blooms dangle above the foliage in late spring and early summer.
