- <u>Use:</u> This delightfully fun, extremely ruffled hosta makes a distinctive specimen in shade gardens and containers. This premium hosta variety is part of a group of the finest hostas available today. To be considered a premium hosta, plants must perform superbly in many zones. They must also exhibit exemplary garden presence and performance, have a long season of appeal in the landscape, have leaves of good substance, and demonstrate a greater resistance to common garden pests.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Part sun–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- *Growth:* Vigorous growing clump, to 11-18" high and 28-30" wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 3-9; Perennial
- Foliage: Deciduous. This delightfully fun, extremely ruffled hosta makes a distinctive specimen in shade gardens and containers. Its green leaves have cream margins which widen as the plants mature, and the leaves are of good substance, making them more slug resistant.
- Flower: Light lavender flowers appear midseason.
