
## Summer Snowdrift Evergreen Candytuft



Use it to edge your driveway in part sun conditions. Lovely drifts of white blossoms resemble drifts of snow.



- <u>Use</u>: Compact, evergreen, and very heavy-blooming, this perennial Candytuft is a pleasure in any sunny to lightly shaded setting. It flowers abundantly in early to mid-spring, forming a carpet of snowy color that makes the perfect backdrop to bulbs, chokes out weeds, and welcomes spring to the garden. Good heat tolerance. Deer resistant.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Sun– part shade. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Superb in borders, beds, and open woodland gardens.
- <u>Growth</u>: Grows 8-10" tall and 1-2' wide or more
- *Hardiness:* Zone 5-10, perennial
- **Foliage:** Herbaceous, evergreen perennial and a floriferous selection for borders, rock gardens or for use as a groundcover.
- Cutting grown.
- *Flower:* Its low-growing, mounding habit complements the small, white, four-petal flowers that appear prolifically each spring.
