## Iberis sempervirens 'Mermaid Lavender'

- <u>Use:</u> The deepest lavender on the market. With lush evergreen mounded foliage, it is a lovely addition to the cottage garden and front of the border. Deer and rabbit resistant. Attracts pollinator bees. Attractive, evergreen, texturally-rich foliage acts as a lovely foil for other plants throughout the rest of the year. Tough as nails and needing little maintenance beyond a light pruning once flowering is done, it gives you a great show for very little effort. Provide good drainage for best plant health. Attracts bees and butterflies! Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– part shade. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Superb in borders, beds, and open woodland gardens.
- <u>Growth</u>: Growing to about 13-18" tall and 6-8" wide, its relaxed mounding form is perfect for gently cascading over the border of a bed or tumbling out of a pot.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 5a-9b, Perennial Heat tolerant.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Herbaceous, evergreen perennial and a floriferous selection for borders, rock gardens or for use as a groundcover.
- <u>Flower:</u> This exciting new variety has a longer blooming period than other lberis and produces flowers in its first year. Blooms start in March and will repeat bloom into fall if you <u>lightly</u> shear flowers after blooming. an excellent cut flower with great vase life.
