Iris 'Renown'

- <u>Use:</u> This hard-to-find white variety is a solid garden performer, a white blooming workhorse for the garden. You can count on flowers to attract hummingbirds and butterflies. They're resistant to deer, gophers and drought! What a winner!
- Exposure/Soil: Plant in full sun to partial shade, in fertile well drained soil. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Grows 32-38" tall. Divide every 3-4 years. Space new container grown plants 18" 36" apart.
- Hardiness: Zone 4-9; Perennial
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. Graceful, thick, long blades.
- <u>Flower</u>: Renown blooms with billowy white <u>fragrant</u> flowers that tumble through the garden in the spring and fall.
