Reddish orange flowers open peachy yellow for a two-tone effect over grass-like foliage.

## Kniphofia uvaria 'Backdraft'

- Use: Members of the PYROMANIA® Collection are a rainbow of hot colors including red, orange, and yellow. The spiky flowers and upright habit gives a very unique drama to your landscape, with rebloom extending the color late into the season. This one is especially attractive to hummingbirds and doesn't appeal to deer. Makes a great cut flower, patio container or landscape plant. Long tap root gives good drought tolerance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun(6+hours of afternoon sun). Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Allow soil to dry slightly between waterings. Drought tolerant once established
- Growth: Fast growing evergreen foliage 24-30in. high, flower spikes 32 to 36 in. tall and a width of 24-30".
- Hardiness: Zone 6-9; Perennial. Very heat and drought tolerant!
- Foliage: Semi-evergreen. Grass-like foliage provides textural contrast to bold-leaved perennials
- **Flower:** A "backdraft" happens when fire explodes with the presence of new oxygen, and this Kniphofia definitely explodes onto the scene of your garden. Very wide flower spikes bear intense reddish orange flowers that open to peachy yellow for a two-tone effect.
