## Red Roulette Hot Poker



Bring unique drama to your landscape with the spiky flowers and upright habit of this perennial. An excellent perennial for the middle of the border.

## Kniphofia uvaria 'Red Roulette'

- <u>Use</u>: Also commonly called Torch Lily for their tall flower spikes. These South Africa natives offer tremendous garden value by combining grass-like foliage with tall flower scapes. An excellent perennial for the middle of the border. The spiky flowers and upright habit gives a very unique drama to your landscape, with rebloom extending the color late into the season. This one is especially attractive to hummingbirds and doesn't appeal to deer. Makes a great cut flower, patio container or landscape plant. Long tap root gives good drought tolerance.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Plant in full sun to partial sun(6+hours of afternoon sun). Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Allow soil to dry slightly between waterings. Drought tolerant once established
- **<u>Growth</u>**: Fast growing evergreen foliage 40-42in. high, 28-32" wide.
- *Hardiness: Zone* 6-9; Perennial. Very heat and drought tolerant!
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Grass-like foliage provides textural contrast to bold-leaved perennials Thin grass-like foliage is exceptionally narrow for Kniphofia and will add fine texture to almost any landscape.
- *Flower:* Deep red-orange buds open to creamy yellow flowers.
