- <u>Use:</u> Unusual two-toned flowers are framed by its silvery foliage making it a garden standout. Dark plum flowers are topped by violet flags, like butterfly wings. Very fragrant it's a good choice for containers, patios, and porches where you can enjoy it up close.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun— part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 6 hours afternoon sun. <u>Soil must be</u> sandy and have a pH of 7, so add lime. NO RED CLAY! Keep water off the leaves, water under foliage.
- **Growth:** Grows 2-3' tall and wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 6-10, Tender perennial. Mulch heavily around the plant
- *Foliage:* Scented leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown.
- <u>Flower:</u> Highly fragrant, keep it deadheaded for non-stop blooms. Fragrant silvery foliage and deep purple blooms topped by cheery lavender flags.
