- <u>Use:</u> Darling Daisy<sup>™</sup> selections are tiny versions of the great garden classic! Growing to a mere six inches tall and wide at maturity, and sometimes taller when in bloom, these darling miniature Daisies are just too cute to pass up! Shasta Daisies are all-time favorites for the perennial border. The cheery flowers begin to appear in early summer and continue on for several months if faithfully deadheaded. Shastas mix so effortlessly with other perennials that no garden should be without them!
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- Growth: Fast growing to 6" tall in bloom. Spreads to 6" in width.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 5-9 Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- Foliage: Deciduous. Dark green foliage.
- <u>Flower:</u> Starts pumping out the miniature white daisy blooms as early as late April and keeps popping until fall!
