- <u>Use:</u> Shasta Daisies are all-time favorites for the perennial border. The cheery flowers begin to appear in early summer and continue on for several months if faithfully deadheaded. Shastas mix so effortlessly with other perennials that no garden should be without them!
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- <u>Growth:</u> Fast growing to 18-24" tall in bloom. Spreads to 20-22" in width.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 5-9 Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- *Foliage*: Deciduous. Dark green foliage.
- <u>Flower:</u> Large, 3" wide, single, pure white, daisy-like flowers with a gold button center formed a solid dome of bloom atop these plants in our trials. It puts on a terrific garden show! A very floriferous plant that has an extra long bloom time in summer. Blooms spring to fall frosts. Deadheading increases flower count.
