***Leucanthemum x maximum* 'Western Star Leo'**

- **Use:** A lovely compact type that reblooms often with cleaning and mixes effortlessly with sages and grasses. A must for any new perennial gardener to try.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 14-20" tall in bloom. Spreads to 18-24" in width.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 4-9 Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Green leaves. Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Umbrella-shaped, white flowers and bright yellow button eye. Removing faded flowers will greatly increase the blooming time. Blooms spring to fall frosts.
