White Blazing Stars/ Gayfeather







Super easy to grow and starry white stalks attract pollinators.



Liatris spicata 'Alba'

- <u>Use:</u> They are equally at home in large, established perennial borders, where their thin, tall, airy floral wands create a mesmerizing "pop-up" effect. A clump forming perennial that has long lasting, fuzzy summer flowers in white that glow in a moonlight garden like fireworks. Attracts butterflies/ hummingbirds, deer resistant, and drought tolerant.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Looks best with occasional to regular irrigation.
- **Growth:** Grows upright to 3-4' tall with 1 1/2" wide
- *Hardiness: Zone* 4-10, perennial
- *Foliage*: Thin green leaves. Deciduous.
- <u>Flower:</u> Unusual spikes of white flowers bloom from the top down..
