
Kobold Blazing Stars/ Gayfeather



Super easy to grow and cheery, purple stalks attract butterflies.



Liatris spicata 'Kobold'

- <u>Use:</u> This more compact cultivar forms low grassy clumps which produce recurring spikes of showy pink blossoms. Naturally adapted to meadow gardens, but equally at home in sunny beds and borders. A longlasting flower, excellent for cut flower arrangements. Attracts butterflies/ hummingbirds, deer resistant, and drought tolerant. Native plant.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Looks best with occasional to regular irrigation.
- Growth: Moderate growing; reaches 2 ft. tall, 1 ft. wide.
- *Hardiness: Zone* 4-9; Perennial
- Foliage: Thin green leaves. Deciduous.
- Flower: Unusual spikes of purple flowers.
